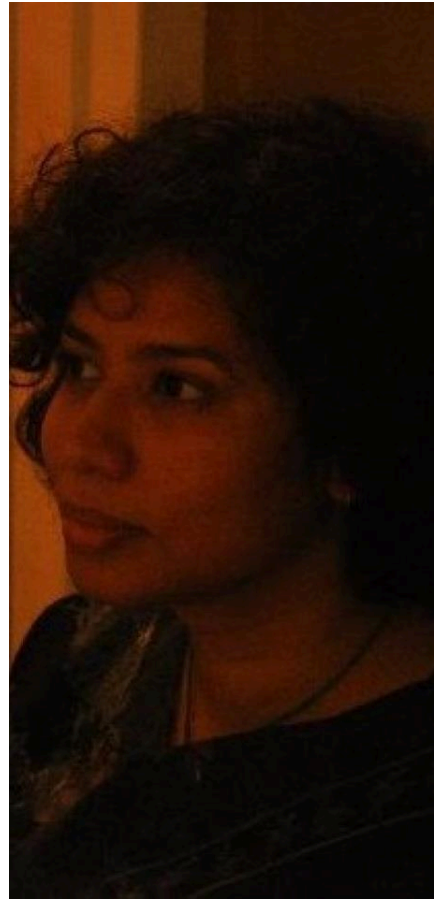
A Message from the Founder and President

✔ This year HatchHope won its first legal battle at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Court

✔ To date, HatchHope has collected 696.1 Lbs of text books worth \$4976.59. The donated books are to be shipped and distributed to specific schools on the African continent.

✔ Thanks to our dedicated patrons, members and staff, to date, HatchHope has provided free medical care to 1475 patients in the slums and refugee camps in Bangladesh.

✔ GuideStar awarded HatchHope their exchange seal for non-profits.

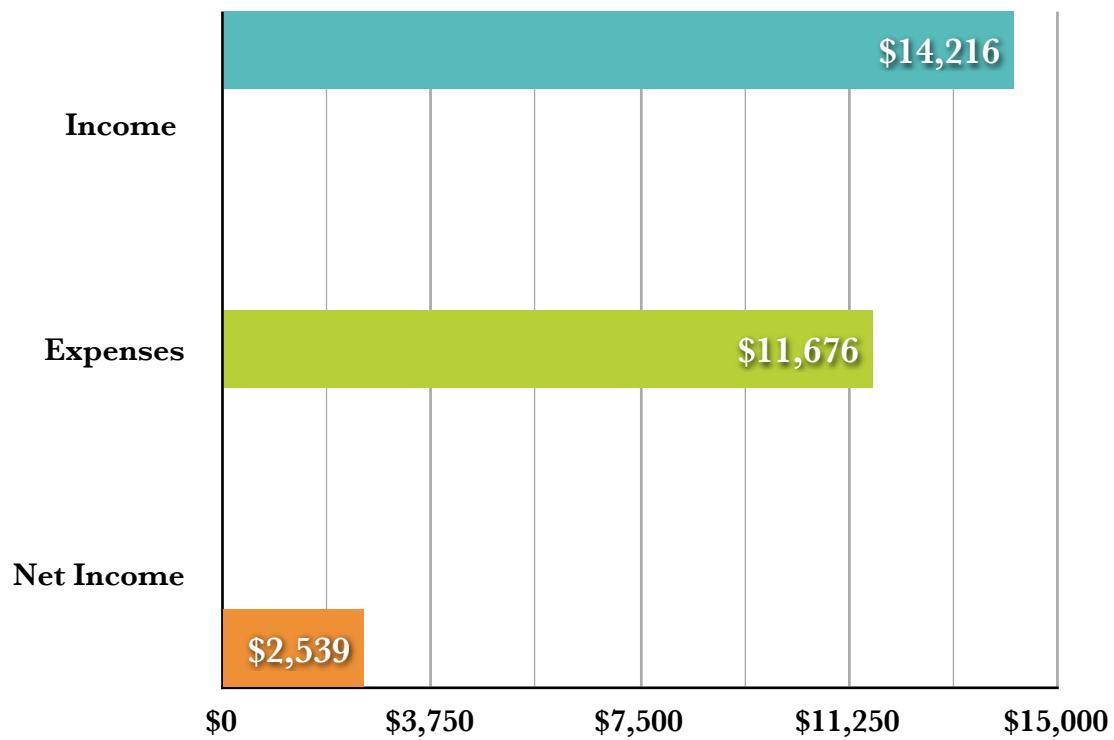

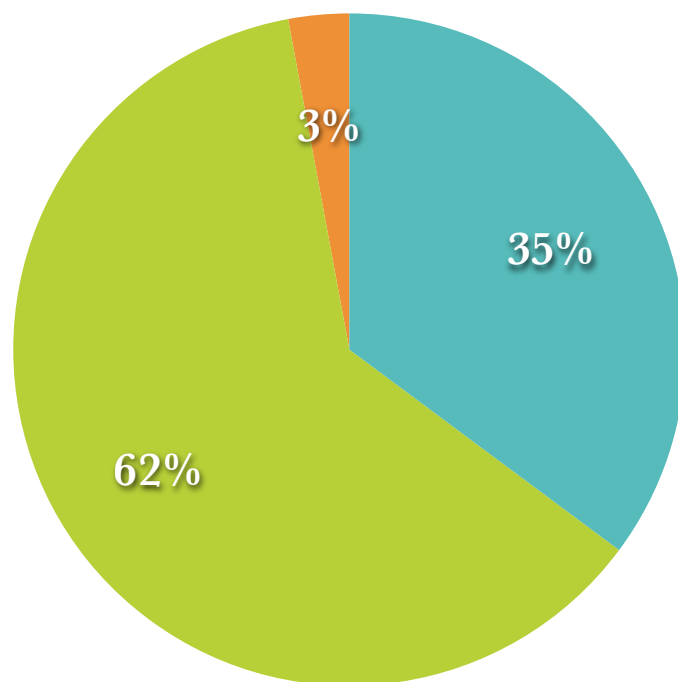


Financial Report: Assets and Expenses

Revenue at a Glance

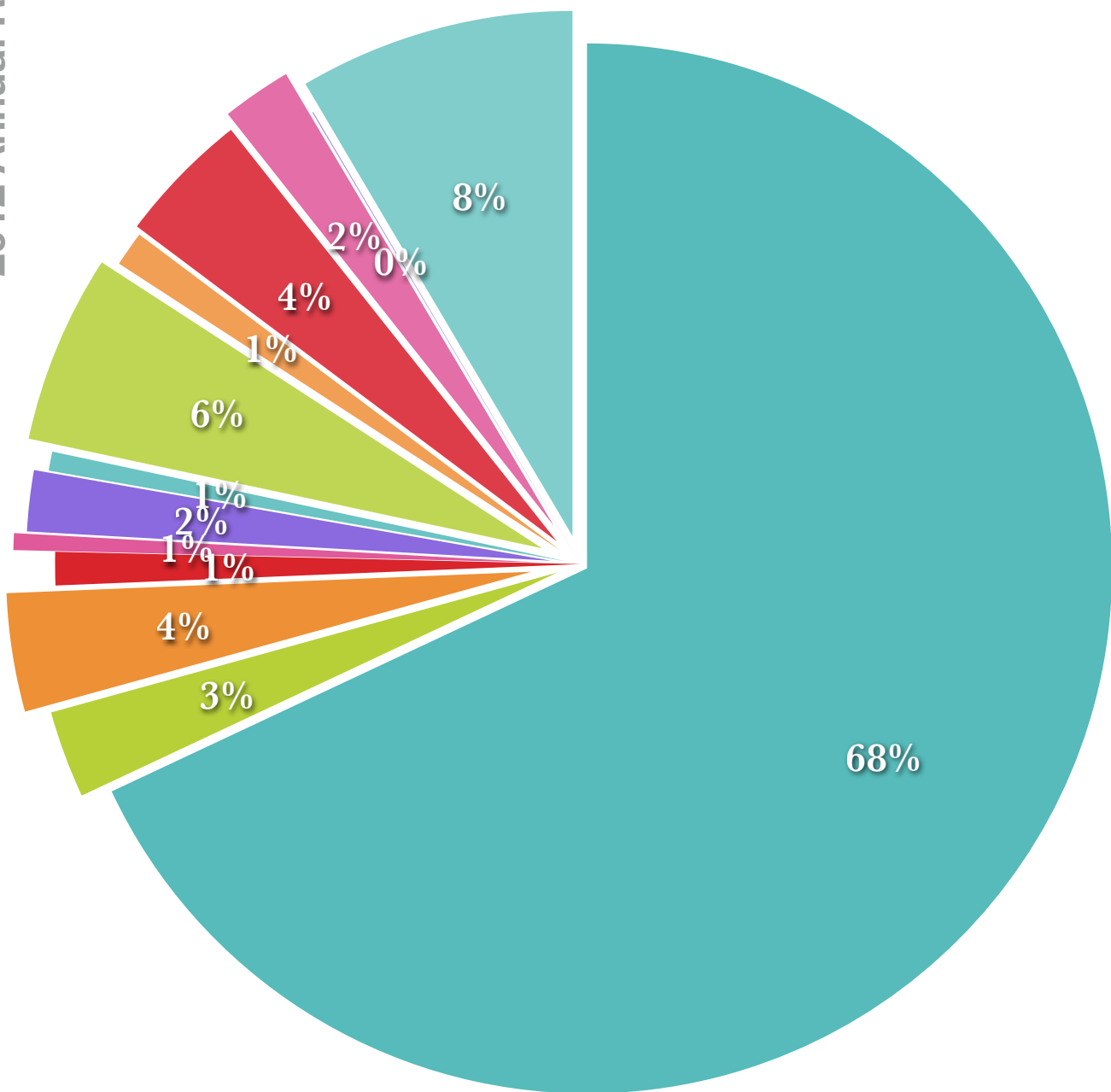


- Direct Public Grants (Foundation and Trust Grants)
